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GILBERT + TOBIN SIGNS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING TO MOVE TO BARANGAROO SOUTH

Lend Lease announced today that leading corporate law firm, Gilbert + Tobin, has signed an exclusive Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on commercial terms for the firm to take more than 9,500 square metres of space in International Towers Sydney at Barangaroo South.

The MoU provides for the negotiation of a binding agreement between Lend Lease and Gilbert + Tobin in respect of the firm taking four high rise floors of Tower 2 at International Towers Sydney. The tower – the central of the three buildings comprising International Towers Sydney – will also house Westpac Banking Corporation.

Gilbert + Tobin's Managing Partner Danny Gilbert said: "We are excited about our potential move to Barangaroo South and the MoU is a positive step in that direction."

Lend Lease's Barangaroo South Managing Director Andrew Wilson said: "This significant MoU shows the confidence that banking, financial services and legal organisations have in Barangaroo South's reinvigoration of a vitally important location in the Sydney CBD."

Mr Wilson said a final agreement with Gilbert + Tobin would mean that more than 80% of Tower 2's space would be occupied.

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
